

According to the World Economic Forum's (WEF) Global Risks Report 2025, misinformation and disinformation emerged as the top risk over the next 2 years, while for the next 10 years, perceived risks are dominated by environmental concerns. The report launched in February 2025 and shared that the most severe threats over the course of the next ten years are: 1) extreme weather events; 2) biodiversity loss and ecosystem collapse; 3) critical change to Earth systems; 4) natural resource shortages; and 5) misinformation and disinformation.
