


How Poland Quietly Became Europe's Battery Powerhouse

Poland is now the world's second-largest battery producer, with 73 GWh of capacity in 2022—trailing only China and ahead of the US. This capacity positions Poland as a critical supplier to Germany, France, and the Netherlands amid Europe's push for electrification and diversification away from China and the US.

Poland has also built an environment attractive to foreign investors in high-tech sectors like batteries, aerospace, and IT. The result is a flywheel effect: foreign capital drives industrial growth, which reinforces export capacity and technological upgrading.
